In Our Cafeteria at Lunch...

We use good manners.

▶ This means that we should eat our own lunch, and use indoor voices.

We respect each other.

▶ This means we should value our friends, the lunch servers, the custodians, and the lunchroom duty staff.

We are safe.

► This means that we should push in our chairs, walk to where we're going, and keep our hands to ourselves.

We clean up after ourselves.

▶ This means that we should leave our lunch tables as we found them. Be sure to recycle when possible and otherwise put our trash in the garbage.

Ideas / Suggestions....

Is someone sitting alone? Ask him or her to join you. Did someone forget to pick up something he or she dropped? Maybe you can pick it up and return it or throw it away.

- ▶ Include anyone who wishes to play.
- ▶ Resolve problems peacefully. We ask an adult for help when needed.
- ▶ Line up quickly when signaled.

Ideas / Suggestions....

Is there a new student in your class? Ask him or her to play a game with you. Is someone being teased or left out? See if you can interest him or her in doing something with you.



In the bathroom...

- ▶ Respect each other's privacy.
- ▶Remember to flush the toilet.
- ▶Wash our hands.
- ▶Leave the bathroom neat and clean.
- ▶ Return to the classroom right away.

Ideas / Suggestions....

Did someone leave the water running? Please turn it off.

Are there paper towels on the floor? Please put them in the trash.

Logical Consequences...(Responsive Classroom) are respectful, relevant, and realistic

Reparation: "You broke it, you fix it."
Loss of privilege: "If you are responsible, you lose a privilege."

Positive Time-Out: used in a consistent, calm, and non-punitive way.
